The aim of the Indian artist was not merely to set down realistic records but to create the semi-magical designs so common in the art of non-Western cultures. Mineral and vegetable pigments provided colourful decorations when applied with a fibre brush to wood or clay or to white-plastered walls in a fresco technique. On battle robes such as this one, made from tanned buffalo hide decorated with deerskin fringe, bird and porcupine quills, and native plant materials, indigenous artists used brown, orange, and green pigments to paint scenes using a complex iconography that detailed their exploits in war.
