At the same time, ethics is reduced to one more tool that facilitates evolutionary progress through the elimination of the weak. He goes on to argue that "testing and selective termination of genetically defective embryos is the only medically and morally defensible way to prevent the existence of people with severe disability, pain and suffering that make their lives not worth living for them on the whole" and that "we are morally required to prevent the existence of people with lives that on balance are not worth living. At present, scientific principles are passed on to trainees primarily by

example and discussion, including training in customary practices.
